morning to serve as an avenue for church members and their disciples to share testimonies and prayer requests. Various cell groups and fellowships of different sectors (youth, young professionals, men, and women) also meet regularly to

reinforce relationships and share the gospel.

The **Ministry of Helps** was overhauled to have a better system of sending assistance to our members. Projects under this includes LEAP for education, feeding programs, community service, donation and assistance, and implementation of LGM projects.





Finally, with God's favor, the monthly targeted budget for the church building construction payment amounting to Php 100,000 (\$2000) is
